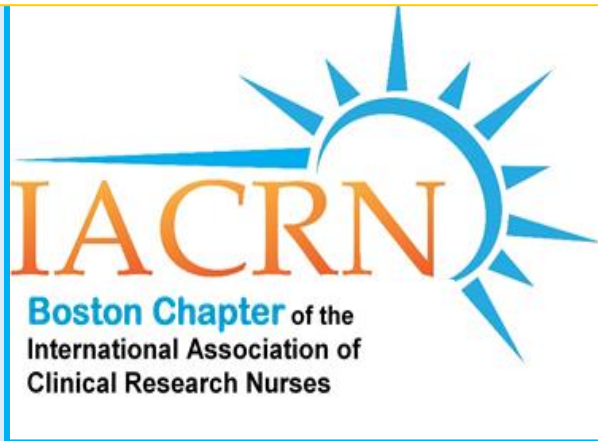

BIACRN Mission

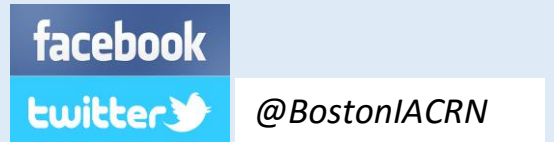
