The IACRN annual conference is only a month away! I always look forward to this time to connect and reconnect with national and international clinical research nurse colleagues. One of the most distinctive qualities of IACRN is its members; they have a passion for sharing their knowledge in support of the global CRN community. It is an incredible experience to spend this time with CRNs who have an enthusiasm and commitment to advance the practice of clinical research nursing. During these 3 days there is never a need to explain my work or clarify a question in the context of clinical research - they all speak the language of research.

Because of the scale of the conference, it offers many opportunities for networking and informal conversations with breakout speakers and conference attendees. I always leave the conference with renewed energy; new insight into challenges faced daily; and a confidence that there are CRN colleagues on which I can always rely to respond to my questions and concerns throughout the coming year.

Our 2019 conference offers an outstanding program of topics and experts. Along with 3 nationally recognized plenary speakers, there are 6 focused workshops, 22 breakout sessions, 8 round table discussions, and 37 poster presentations that provide a global perspective on a variety of research topics.

This is the only research conference planned and carried out entirely by CRNs, for the sole purpose of meeting the educational request of CRNs gathered directly from responses to an annual member-wide gap analysis survey.

Additionally, there will be 2 panel discussions - the first we will hear from members who attended the international site visit in London this year and the second discussion will share experiences from those who participated in the first IACRN Leadership Program. Time has been set aside for a meet and greet of international attendees, providing another opportunity to link with other CRN colleagues from across the globe. All of this offers 16.25 CEU's in the 3-day conference!
